NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT

***AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALEX ANDRIA AMENDING THE BURNING
ORDINANCE***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Alexandria Borough Council will on Monday, November 2, 1998 at 7:30 P.M. at a meeting of the Borough Council of Alexandria Borough to be held at the Scout Building in Alexandria, Pennsylvania, consider the adoption of an ordinance amending the Burning Ordinance prohibiting the burning of paper or refuse outdoors (1) within twenty (20) feet of any building or the opening of any building or within twenty (20) feet of any side property line or street line, or within twenty-five (25) feet of a rear property line or street line; (2) on Hartslog Day; and (3) establishing times of the day when burning shall be permitted; namely , Monday through Thursday from 7:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. and Friday and Saturday from 7:00 A.M. until 11:00 **A.M.** Styrofoam is a form of plastic and therefore is not approved for burning.

ORDINANCE ADDENDUM**

ARTICLE 4 BURNING

4.01 A. No person shall burn any paper or refuse outdoors within twenty (20) feet of any building, or the opening of any building, or within twenty (20) feet of any side property line or street line, or within twenty-five (25) feet of a rear property line or street line.

C. No fire shall be kindled or maintained on Sunday or legal holidays. Hartslog Day shall for the purpose of this ordinance be considered a holiday. Burning shall be permitted on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 7:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. and Friday and Saturday of each week from 7:00 A. M. until 11:00 A.M. Fires must be tended at all times until the fire is out.


D. The burning of garbage , vegetable waste, rubber, plastics, furniture, glass, metals, crocking, car products or any other materials which will create nauseous or noxious fumes, smoke, toxic chemicals or excessive fly ash, is specifically prohibited. Styrofoam is a form of plastic and is therefore **not** approved for burning.

Adopted by the Alexandria Borough Council the
2nd day of November, 1998. Effective immediately.
