

**Article 3**  
**Parking**

**301. General Regulations.**

No person shall park a vehicle, or permit it to stand, whether attended or unattended, upon a highway or street in any of the following places.

1. Within an intersection.
2. On a cross walk.
3. Within 25 feet from the intersection of curb lines or within 15 feet from the intersection of property lines at a street or highway intersection.
4. Within 40 feet upon the approach of a stop sign or traffic signal.
5. Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or approach to a fire station.
6. On a side walk.
7. In front of a private highway.
8. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the curb or edge of highway.
9. At any place where official signs or markers prohibit standing or parking.
10. Unlicensed vehicles or disabled vehicles shall not be parked on any highway or street for more than 24 hours.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction thereof before the Burgess of Alexandria or any Justice of the Peace in the Borough of Alexandria, in the nature of a summary conviction proceeding, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of two (\$2.00) payable to the Borough of Alexandria and costs, or in default *bf* payment thereof, to be sentenced to imprisonment in the County Jail for one (1) day.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

### **302. Hartslog Street.**

7. From the effective date of this Ordinance, the East side of Hartslog Street between Main Street and Shelton Avenue is hereby designated a No Parking Zone twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, said area also being designated a fire lane, and the members of the Borough Council of Alexandria, or their duly authorized representatives, are hereby given authority to erect No Parking Signs and take appropriate measures for the enforcement of this Ordinance in accordance with the provisions hereinafter concerning enforcement.
  
8. The owner or driver of any vehicle in violation of paragraph one of this Ordinance may within forty-eight (48) hours after the time that a Notice in the form prescribed by the Borough Council of Alexandria is placed upon the vehicle in violation of paragraph one of this Ordinance pay to the Borough Council Secretary or duly authorized agent in the full the minimum fine as hereinafter established. If such owner or driver of a vehicle in violation of paragraph one of this Ordinance shall fail within forty-eight (48) hours to settle for such violation, such owner or driver may thereafter settle for a sum double the minimum fine hereinafter prescribed. If any owner or driver of any vehicle in violation of paragraph one of this Ordinance shall fail to pay the Borough Council Secretary or duly authorized Agent under the above provisions, upon conviction of violation of paragraph one of this Ordinance before a Justice of the Peace, such owner or driver shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than two (\$2.00) nor more than ten (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.
  
9. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
