Article 3

Joint Water and Sewer

301. Grant of Rights and Privileges.

- 1. This Borough does grant to the Authority, its successors and assigns, all easements, rights-of-way and other rights necessary and desirable in, along over and under streets, roads, lanes, courts, cul-de-sacs, alleys, public ways, public ingress, egress and regress therein and thereto, along with other persons having interests or rights therein, for use in connection with constructing, replacing, repairing, altering and maintaining the sewer system to be acquired and constructed by the Authority as the same shall exist, from time to time.
- 2. The rights and privileges granted to the Authority under paragraph 1 shall be exercised by the Authority under and subject to such reasonable rules, regulations and conditions as shall be adopted and specified, from time to time, by resolution or ordinance of this Borough; and this Borough does reserve the right to adopt and specify, from time to time, such reasonable rules, regulations and conditions in connection with exercise by the Authority of such rights and privileges.
- 3. This Ordinance shall become Effective Date. immediately.
- 4. Severability. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of this Borough that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Repealer. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsiste nt herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.

302. Construction of System; Connection Requirement.

- 1. This Borough shall enter into an Agreement dated as of April 15, 1975 (the "Agreement"), between this Borough and Alexandria Borough-Porter Township Joint Sewer and Water Authority (the "Authority"), whereby, inter alia, the Authority covenants, inter alia, to construct, acquire and operate a complete sanitary sewage collection and treatment and disposal system and whereby this Borough makes certain convents and agreements with respect to the sewer system, as such phrase is defined in the Agreement; to be owned and operated by the Authority, including requiring all owners of improved property located in this Borough and benefited, improved or accommodated by any sanitary sewer constituting a part of the sewer system to connect therewith, and granting certain easements and rights-of -way to the Authority, substantially in the form presented to this meeting, which Agreement is approved.
- 2. A copy of the Agreement, in the form so presented to this meeting and so approved, shall be filed with the Secretary of this Borough and shall be made available for inspection at reasonable times by interested persons requesting such inspection.
- 3. Repealer. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith expressly are repealed.
