Streets, Sidewalks, Addresses

An Ordinance of Alexandria Borough, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania Establishing Street Addresses Within the Borough Limits and Naming Two Previously Unnamed Lanes

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Alexandria Borough Council that the street addresses within the Borough are hereby established as more fully set forth on the attached Borough Street Plan marked Schedule A.

SECTION 2. Be it enacted and ordained by the Alexandria Borough Council that the following two lanes shall be named and known hence forth as follows:

A. Melvin's Lane

Beginning at the eastern edge of the Borough corporate limits and extending in a westerly direction to the eastern line of Hartslog Street; said lane being located between Shelton Avenue and the northern corporate limits and parallel thereto, all as more fully set forth on the attached Schedule A.

B. Brewhouse Lane

Beginning at the western edge of the Borough corporate limits and extending in an easterly direction along the Borough southern corporate limits to an alley dividing the properties known as 514-512 Main Street, as more fully set forth on the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.
