**ORDINANCE NO. 2001- 1**  
**AN ORDINANCE OF ALEXANDRIA BOROUGH, HUNTINGDON COUNTY,**  
**PENNSYLVANIA REGARDING MUNICIPAL WASTE AND JUNK**

**SECTION 1. MUNICIPAL WASTE (rubbish, garbage )**

a. All exterior property and premises , and the interior of every structure shall be free from any accumulation of municipal waste except in such limited quantities and for such limited periods of time as shall ensure that no annoyance, nuisance, health or fire hazard shall be created.

b. Any unauthorized accumulation of municipal waste on any premises is hereby declared to be a nuisance and is prohibited.

c. The owner of every occupied premises shall supply containers for municipal waste, and the owner of the premises shall be responsible for the removal of municipal waste.

d. All borough residents shall be required to contract with a licensed hauler for the disposal of municipal waste. The hauler must provide said service so that not more than fourteen (14) days of accumulation of municipal waste exist at any given time.

**SECTION 2. JUNK**

a. All exterior property and premises shall be free from any accumulation of any discarded material or article and shall include, but not limited to, scrap metal, scrapped , abandoned, or junked motor vehicles, machinery , equipment , paper, glass, containers and structures.

b. Any unauthorized accumulation of junk on any premises is hereby declared to be a nuisance and is prohibited.


**SECTION 3. VIOLATIONS**

a. Any violation or failure to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, which may be abated. All cost incurred by the Borough in abating a nuisance may be recovered from the responsible party or property owner. Said violation shall also constitute a summary offense, and any person convicted thereof in a summary proceeding before a District Magistrate shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars or more than three hundred (\$300.00) dollars and the cost of prosecution. Each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.
