ORDINANCE NO.

97-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF
ALEXANDRIA, HUNTINGDON COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS
GOVERNING THE OPERATION OF AND THE
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON MAIN
STREET WITHIN THE BOROUGH DURING SNOW
AND ICE STORMS, AND DURING THE REMOVAL
OF SNOW AND/OR ICE FROM OR ON MAIN
STREET, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE,
REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR
PORTIONS THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR
PARTIAL INVALIDITY, AND ESTABLISHING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council
of the Borough of Alexandria, and it is hereby
ordained and enacted by
authority of the same:

A. TITLE.

1. This Ordinance shall be known and may be
cited as the "Alexandria Borough Snow Removal
Ordinance".

B. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect the
public health, safety and welfare, and to
facilitate the safe movement of vehicular
traffic and combat the hazard of snow and ice
on Main Street within the Borough.

C. DEFINITIONS.

The following definitions shall apply to the
interpretation and enforcement of this Ordinance:

1. "Snow Storm": Any weather condition in
which snow, sleet or freezing rain accumulates to a
depth of two (2) inches

or greater.____

2. "Vehicles": Any and all motor vehicles and trailers, including by way of example and not by way of limitation passenger automobiles, trucks, buses, public and private transportation, motorized conveyances, etc., using Main Street.

3. "Borough": The Borough of Alexandria, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania.

PARKING ON MAIN STREET DURING OR AFTER SNOW STORMS

1. During any snow storm, vehicles shall be permitted to park only on the odd numbered side of Main Street on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and on the even numbered side of Main Street on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. No parking shall be permitted on Main Street except as provided herein until such time as plowing, salting and/or cindering has been completed.

2. The registered owner of any vehicle who violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to the penalties prescribed hereinafter.

3. Any vehicle which has been parked, becomes stalled and/or is incapable of moving under its own power, or is left unattended on Main Street in violation of the provision of this section may be removed or towed by persons authorized by Alexandria Borough to do so. The cost of removal and towing of

any such vehicles shall be assessed by the Borough against the Registered Owner of the vehicle, and the recovery of the costs of such removal and towing shall be recovered as part of the fine for violating the provisions of this section of this Ordinance.

E. DEPOSITING SNOW ONTO MAIN STREET

1. No person shall throw, shovel, cast or otherwise place, pile, deposit or dump snow or ice removed from sidewalks, walkways, driveways, or any other locations onto Main Street.

F. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

1. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, any person or registered owner of any vehicle who or which violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Three Hundred and 00/100 (\$300.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution and costs for the towing and storage of vehicles as permitted in this Ordinance.

G. SEVERABILITY.

1. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect the constitutionality, legality or validity of this Ordinance as a whole, nor the constitutionality, legality or validity of any other section or provision of this Ordinance other than the one so declared to

be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid.

H. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

2. All existing Ordinances of the Borough or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

I. EFFECTIVE DATE

1. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
