Ordinance No. 2003-2

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE AND CHANGE ROAD/ STREET NAMES TO IMPLEMENT THE HUNTINGDON COUNTY 911 ADDRESSING SYSTEM

Whereas, Huntingdon County is implementing the 911 Addressing System which, when completed, will provide for improved emergency response that benefits the health, safety and welfare of all citizens of this municipality; and

Whereas, in order to implement this system, it is necessary to develop an addressing system that is comprehensive, expandable and easily understood; and

Whereas, Huntingdon County had developed an addressing plan for the entire County which is based on a linear system that will provide a unique physical location address; and

Whereas, in order to implement this system, it is required that all public roads or streets within the municipality be named or renamed to eliminate duplicate road names within the delineated 911 addressing region and United States Postal Service zip code areas, and to name and mark certain private roadways within the municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough

Council of the Borough of Alexandria as follows:

Section 1. That the names of the existing Alexandria Borough public roads, and state public roads shown on the attached list and map are valid and official road names in the municipality and that hereafter these streets or roads shall be identified and officially recognized by the names indicated herein;

Section 2. That the private roadways identified on the attached list and map are valid and official road names in the municipality and shall be hereafter known by the names indicated herein;


Section 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Clerk of Courts of Huntingdon County, Huntingdon County 911, and the appropriate Office of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the purpose of securing official documentation of the names herby designated;


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until modified or repealed by further Ordinance of the governing body; and

Section 5. That all Ordinances or Resolutions and parts of Ordinances or Resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

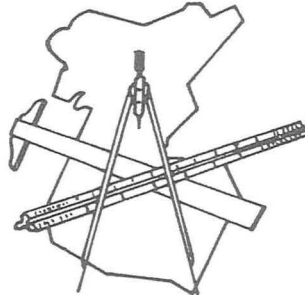

RE: 911 Addressing and Street Naming Dear Ms. Ryzner:

Huntingdon County has received approval from the U.S. Postal Service to release addresses for your municipality. In connection with this process, we need to confirm previously agreed upon street names. In this regard, we are requesting your signature on a municipal map displaying all streets and your adoption of a street naming ordinance. Availability of physical addresses will improve emergency response and mail delivery and provide accurate location information to the travelling public.

It is critical that you carefully review the street names in your municipality for correctness. This review should include street name spelling, route number identification (if present) and location. Upon completion of this review, sign both enclosed maps (noting any errors); return one signed map to our office, retaining one for your files. Upon receipt of this map, and others in your postal area, we will initiate the issuance of new addresses.

Finally, we recommend the adoption of all street names by municipal ordinance as the final step to insure that the Borough officially recognizes all street names. The Pennsylvania Borough Code provides your municipality the authority to provide and regulate the naming of streets (Section 1201 [25]). This is also consistent with the Huntingdon County Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance. It is County policy to closely coordinate the street naming and addressing with your municipality. We are providing a draft Street Naming Ordinance for your use (see enclosure). Please review it with your solicitor prior to adoption.
