NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Alexandria , Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania (the "Borough"), at a meeting of the Council of the Borough duly called and held on August 11, 2003, finally enacted an Ordinance (the "Ordinance"), the caption and a summary of such Ordinance being as follows:

**"AN ORDINANCE**

**OF THE COUNCIL OF THIS BOROUGH DETERMINING TO INCUR LEASE RENTAL DEBT EVIDENCED BY THE GUARANTY OF A 2003 GUARANTEED WATER REVENUE NOTE, IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$995,422, TO BE ISSUED BY ALEXANDRIA BOROUGH WATER AUTHORITY . IN CONNECTION WITH A CAPITAL PROJECT CONSISTING OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING ADDITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE AUTHORITY'S PUBLIC WATER SYSTEM IN AND ABOUT THE BOROUGH, AND PAYING RELATED COSTS AND EXPENSES; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING APPROPRIATE OFFICERS OF THE BOROUGH TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS AND TO EXECUTE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEBT; PROVIDING FOR THE GUARANTY OF THIS BOROUGH OF PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE NOTE; PLEDGING THE FULL FAITH, CREDIT, AND TAXING POWER OF THIS BOROUGH IN SUPPORT OF THE NOTE; CREATING A SINKING FUND IN CONNECTION WITH THE BOROUGH'S GUARANTY OBLIGATION AS PROVIDED IN SUCH ACT; APPOINTING A SINKING FUND DEPOSITORY IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH GUARANTY OBLIGATION; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES."**

Notice is given further that:

1. The full text of the Ordinance (and the form of the Guaranty Agreement approved by the Ordinance), no amendments having been made thereto during final passage, may be examined by any citizen at the Alexandria Memorial Library, Main Street, Alexandria,

Pennsylvania, on Monday and Thursday between the hours of 10:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. and 6:30 P.M. and 8:00 P.M., prevailing time; on Tuesday, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., prevailing time; or on Friday, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M., prevailing time.

2. The aforementioned Guaranty Agreement provides for the Borough's guarantee of the Alexandria Borough Water Authority's maximum annual debt service payments, ranging from a low maximum guaranteed annual debt service payment of \$2,046.15 to a high maximum guaranteed annual debt service payment of \$54,934.68.
